INTRUDUCTION

"South America Rugby Sevens 2017" is a tournament organized by South America Rugby with the endorsement of World Rugby and with Delegated Participation of the hosting Unions of Uruguay and Chile. Will be governed by the Regulations and Rules of the game of World Rugby. In the absence of any express regulations in particular and / or of interpretation and application of the World Rugby Rules, the South America Rugby Executive Committee will be the responsible for solving it.

The "South America Rugby Sevens 2017" Circuit consists of two stages:

Stage 1: Punta del Este Uruguay, Friday 6 and Saturday 7, January 2017.

Stage 2: Viña del Mar Chile, Saturday 14 and Sunday 15, January 2017.

COMPETITION PROCEDURES

- 1) TEAMS SQUADS will consist of a maximum of 12 players and 2 staff.
- 2) Final List: In the manager's meeting each delegate must present the final list with 12 players.
- 4) ACCIDENT INSURANCE: All players must have an accident insurance, which will be presented to the Tournament Commissioner.
- 5) ELIGIBILITY: Players must be eligible to play for the country they represent, in accordance with World Rugby rules on this subject.

6) Technical Meeting or Manager Meeting: will be established the day before the start of the tournament at a time and place to be confirmed by the Match Commissioner. This will be responsible for the information to each manager of this meeting.

Competition rules

The competition will be played according with the

1. WORLD RUGBY LAWS OF THE GAME: laws.worldrugby.org
2. CHANGES AND SUBSTITUTIONS: A maximum of 5 changes per game will be allowed.
3. DURATION: All matches will be played in two fractions of 7 minutes each, with no more than 2 minutes of rest between both periods. (Including Gold, Silver and Bronze Finals)
4. DETERMINING POSITIONS FOLLOWING POOL MATCHES
Following the completion of the pool round, the following rules will be used to populate the knockout-round brackets. Teams will be ranked in their pool according to their total number of classification points. Three points will be awarded for a win, two points for a draw and one point for a loss.
 - A. 3 points match won.
 - B. 2 points tied match.
 - C. 0 points match lost.
5. If a match during the knockout stage of the competition is tied after full time has been called by the referee, extra time will be played until a winner is determined. A two-minute water break will be held at the end of normal time and before recommencing the match. The extra time will be played in periods of five minutes. After each period, the teams will change ends without interval. In extra time, the team which scores first will immediately be declared the winner without further play.
6. **DISCIPLINARY:** This tournament will proceed under the regulations of World Rugby for Seven a side determined at the Regulation 17.
7. **Anti-Doping:** This tournament will be regulated under World Rugby doping rules under the WADA Regulations.
8. **Anti-Corruption and Integrity.** This tournament will be regulated under the rules of World Rugby Regulations. (Regulations 6 WR).
